

## **Stewart Park Tree Donation Program**

This program allows donors to contribute a specimen tree for planting in Stewart Park in order to honor or memorialize family members, friends, pets or events in a permanent way.

The donor chooses an area of Stewart Park where they would like the tree to be planted. Selection of an appropriate species and the exact placement of each tree are at the discretion of Association representatives, with the donor's final approval.

The tree will be planted within 6 months of the request, and payment of the donation is expected at the time of tree purchase. The cost of the memorial tree, which depends on the species chosen, includes purchase, planting, mulching, and a maintenance fee.

If the donor chooses to have a marker installed, an additional sum will be required for its production and installation. Selection and placement of a marker will be made by agreement between the donor and Association representatives.

All donations will be maintained as park property for as long as PHNIA exists. In the event of destruction or defacement, PHNIA agrees to repair or replace these donations to the best of their ability: A new tree with a minimum height matching that of the original planting will be planted and cared for at that location, and the marker will either be repaired or replaced.
